- v) **It agrees to pay for the hire of the Thurlow Pavilion for the Marina Mae Concert on 5th June 2022 at a cost of £70.**
- vi) **It agrees to pay for the hire of temporary toilets.**
- vii) **It agrees to quotes being obtained for risk assessments for some of the activities.**
- viii) **It agrees with £100 being set aside for prizes.**
- ix) **It agrees with a charge of £5 per ticket for the Barn Dance and the Marina Mae Concert.**
